December is "Disease Prevention and Treatment Month"



Now, we are almost halfway through the Rotary year with only one month left in 2023.

How is everyone doing?

The World Polio Day Event on October 29th brought together over 300 Rotary members and the Rotary family in a walk rally, which I found a very impactful activity. I would like to thank the Membership Committee, Public Image Committee, The Rotary Foundation Committee, who organized the event, and all the participants from the bottom of my heart.

Now, December is Disease Prevention and Treatment Month. The Rotary Foundation is dedicated to preventing and treating disease by providing grants for projects and activities around the world.

Providing clean water: In Ghana, we are working with other organizations to provide clean water to more than 80% of the country's population to prevent Guinea worm infections.

Reducing HIV infections: In Liberia, we are supporting HIV testing for women in their early stage of pregnancy and promoting prenatal care with the aim to reduce mother-to-child transmission of HIV by 95% in two years.

Eradication of polio: We have played a major role in the global eradication of polio (childhood paralysis). Our intense effort has not only eliminated polio from nearly every country in the world but has also created an infrastructure that can be used for other disease

tracking systems, such as Ebola hemorrhagic fever. We are very close to achieving polio eradication.

Similar to last year, I completed the 300-kilometer cycling challenge across Japan (from Niigata to Tokyo) in 20 hours in the hope of eradicating polio. The success of the END POLIO Cycling Challenge 2023 was due to the thorough preparation and the support team of the Rotary Club of Tokyo Mitaka and Rotaract Club who participated in this event. I am very grateful. Next year, I would like to take another Cycling Challenge 2024 across Japan (East-West on the Pacific side).

I would like to share with you again this month a quote from Paul Harris.
